Watercolor Paints

You may wish to avoid cadmium tubes:

Primary colors can get you started: yellow, medium red, medium ultramarine blue

Other color suggestions: permanent green alizarin crimson, sap green, burnt sienna orange, rose, cerulean blue. This list can go on!

Brands: Winsor Newton or Cotman are great, Grumbacher is fine. Winsor Newton, Cotman box can also work well. You can find these at Michael's Arts and Crafts in Weymouth. Be sure to use discounts.

Watercolor Papers

Watercolor blocks Arches paper is wonderful but, expensive. Cranson 140lb 9x12 or larger is fine Strathmore is also good.

Watercolor Brushes

A round #10 or #12 . A flat 1/2 inch or $^{3\!\!4}$ wash brush size also a smaller 1/4 flat

Misc

Bring along masking tape, a rag and container for water, palette for mixing – can be an old plate or plastic watercolor palette. You can purchase these with lids for reuse. HB pencil and white Staedtle eraser and drawing paper.
